prepares children to become lifelong learners and problem solvers.

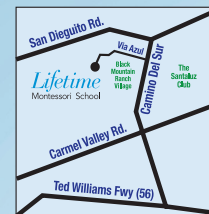

Programs for Toddlers Through 6th Graders



Toddler Program

For children 18 months through 3 years old

Half day:
9 a.m.-noon

Full day:
9 a.m.- 3 p.m.

Our Toddler Program's goal is to create a sense of accomplishment, pride and independence for toddlers. Under the nurturing guidance of our teachers, they learn to care for themselves and their environment (potty training, dressing themselves, cleaning up toys, etc.) as well as refine motor skills, through hands-on activities and games. Toddlers are also exposed to art and music, and they gain invaluable socialization experiences.



Primary Program

For 3-year-olds through kindergarteners

Half day:
8:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m.

Full day:
8:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m.

Our three-year Primary Program, which includes kindergarten, prepares children for first grade; 3-, 4- and 5-year-olds are welcome to join it at any stage. Children are provided with an interactive, hands-on and educational environment so they can become self-motivated and successful learners. They're free to explore their senses to fully understand the world around them, and provided with invaluable security and consistency.



Elementary Program

For ages 6 through 12 years old (1st through 6th graders)

Full day:
8:30 a.m.-3 p.m.

At the elementary level, our goal is to give children the universe and help them find their place in it. Students from age 6 to 12 have a strong drive to build their own intellect; knowledge is imparted through their efforts to follow intellectual interest in their own way and at their own pace. With our vast, fascinating curriculum and our skilled elementary guides, students conduct their own learning. Our program produces joyful lifelong learners who love exploring the unknown, and self-confidence that lets them know they can accomplish almost anything.
